Mariemont Senior Signs Baseball Commitment



On May 7, 2008, Davey Moreton, a senior at Mariemont High School, signed a National Letter of Intent to play baseball for the University of Charleston Golden Eagles in Charleston, West Virginia. University of Charleston is a member of the NCAA Division II and the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC). Moreton will join their roster as a pitcher.

At Mariemont High School, Moreton was a four-year varsity letter winner in baseball for the Warriors. He also played football and basketball his freshman and sophomore years. In 2006, his sophomore year, he received the Most Improved Pitcher award. Davey is also a two-time Cincinnati Hills League Scholar Athlete.
