Mariemont Senior Selected to Girls Soccer All-America Team



Mariemont High School senior Kelsey Hogan has earned selection to the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/adidas High School Girls All-America Team.

Hogan's post season honors also include her 3rd year first team All-Conference, 2nd year first team Cincinnati Enquirer All-City, 3rd year first team Southwest Ohio and 2nd year first team All-Ohio. This year, Hogan was also named Southwest Ohio's DII Player of the Year. Playing forward for Mariemont, Hogan smashed the program's existing career goal record by 20 goals, ending her high school soccer career with a total of 71 goals.

Mariemont Girls Varsity Soccer coach Mike Haney believes the accolades for Kelsey are well deserved. "Kelsey has been a key to this program's success for the last four years. You can't replace a player like her, but we can use what she's done here as a new standard for excellence. We can't begin to express how much she'll be missed.

Coach Haney also garnered post-season honors being named Southwest Ohio DII Girls Soccer coach of the year.
