### **Mariemont HS Student Photographers Advance to State Competition**

Two Mariemont High School students have had photographs selected into the regional competition of the 2011 Governor's Youth Art Exhibit. Freshman Katie Robinson and junior Michael Weston's photos now advance to the state level of competition in Columbus.

Only 2,500 student art pieces from over 12,000 are chosen from fifteen regions of Ohio. Of those 2,500, 300 will be selected for the actual state exhibit and twenty-five will receive the Governor's Award of Excellence. Many of the student artists will be offered college scholarships from a variety of schools.

2011 marks the 41<sup>st</sup> year for the exhibit which will be displayed at the James A. Rhodes State Office Tower in Columbus from April through May.

The students' photography instructor at Mariemont High School is Kim Richardson.
