### **Mariemont High School Sets Another Record for AP® Scholar Awards**

Mariemont High School students from the Classes of 2010 and 2011 have set another record for the largest number of AP Scholars in the history of Mariemont High School. Sixty students at Mariemont High School have earned the designation of AP Scholar by the College Board in recognition of their exceptional achievement on the college-level Advanced Placement Program® Exams. The College Board recognizes several levels of achievement based on student's performance on the exams.

K. McKenzie Miller and Brennen Warner were named "National AP Scholars" by earning an average grade of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, **and** grades of 4 or higher on eight or more of the exams.

Twenty-seven students qualified for "AP Scholar with Distinction" by earning an average grade of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, **and** grades of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.
