

# Facilities Update Weekly

January 3, 2011

## High School:

- No facilities work currently being done.

## Fairfax Elementary:

- No facilities work currently being done.

## Mariemont Elementary:

- Neyer Plumbing will be on-site at Mariemont starting this week (probably Wednesday) for the water main and sanitary piping for the modular units. They will be cutting a trench for the pipes then covering it. Much of the work that could impact student arrival and dismissal will be done over the four day weekend of Jan. 14-17. As we get more information on when arrival and dismissal will be impacted, we will notify you through school email and updates. Some of the football field will be fenced off during the digging.
- We are building a wall next to the Parish Center to allow for widening of the drive between the building and the tennis courts.
- Some trees will have to be taken down for the modular buildings and new building.\* We will be landscaping and replacing trees closer to the end of the project.

## Terrace Park Elementary:

- All underground piping to the bio-field and lift station for the septic system is completed.
- Wiring for power and controls in-between the vaults for the system will begin this week.
- The installation of all tanks at Stanton Road is completed.
- The 3" main has been connected to the existing service and all piping has been installed for it.
- Neyer Plumbing is blacktopping the trenches and street.
- Some trees will have to be taken down for the modular buildings and the new building.\* We will be landscaping and replacing trees closer to the end of the project.

## FYI

- The modular units will be arriving in late January and early February at Mariemont and Terrace Park.

- \*While we are trying to remove as few trees as possible, we will be working with the villages to make sure that trees are replaced and that the character of the school campuses remains "green".
