High School:

- No new facility work going on at this time.

Mariemont Junior High at Fairfax Site:

- No facilities work currently being done. Early Site Work Bid packages are being prepared.
- The playground will be closed and removed during construction.
- Bids will be going out for Early Site Work and Site Utilities.

Mariemont Elementary:

- Bids will be going out for the Early Site Work and Demolition package Asbestos Abatement and for the Tower Crane.
- The modular building units will arrive at various times over the next few weeks. The units must be connected to each other. They will be put on piers and anchored. The units will come from Wooster Pike onto Plainville then brought down the church driveway byu the tennis courts.
